### **The High Ropes Course**

Challenge yourself at the climbing wall, zip line, rappelling wall, leap of faith and “The Screamer”. The high ropes course operates for one and a half hours by our trained instructors. Participants must wear closed toed shoes.

### **Horses**

Spend an hour taking a trail ride through the beautiful hill country led by one of our wranglers. Participants must wear long pants and closed toed shoes.

### **Mountain Biking**

Enjoy riding a 3 mile trail that loops around the property, led by a guide. If you prefer riding on the road, the countryside is beautiful as you follow an eight or sixteen mile route through the hill country.

### **Canoes**

Relax while canoeing down the peaceful Guadalupe River. Canoeing is unsupervised and an adult must be present in each canoe.

### **Teaching and Music**

If you would like His Hill to provide the music and teaching, arrangements can be made. The cost for this service is \$175. This includes three teaching and music sessions.
